Goonawarra GC Review

June 29th 2025: We had 20 players at Goonawarra which included 2 visitors. Several late withdrawals due to cart availability, and others unable to attend. It was a nice start to the day, as the weather wasn't too bad, and the wind was slight. The rule of the day was lift, clean and place in the fairway and the rough. Not a good omen.

The Matchplay Final was held between Tony Kastropil and Tony Khoury, more details in the Matchplay section.

The format for the day was Scratch PLUS a putting competition. Every time you used your putter, whether on or off the green, it was "supposed" to count as a putt. A tweak to the rules: a maximum of 9 shots per hole, and if you didn't complete your putting then three putts was to be assigned.



Reminder for those paying cash on the day...l'm not an ATM! Correct monies please, and no loose change, else a credit will be raised.

Being in the last group, I saw many a great drive, and a couple of players that didn't get passed the lady's tee. Thinking themselves safe, some players started looking for the ball that went into the scrub right of the tee-box, to have another toed shot heading into the same location. There was a shout, you could have yelled "Fore!".

We were stunned watching Daniel Kohut on the par-3 3rd. After putting his first ball into the water, rolling in up near the green,

then taking a one-shot penalty, he then chipped it in for par. What a shot!

It was heard at the 19th hole that George Makohon also had a chip in. But the best was Stefan Moskaljuk, who on the par 5 8th, after a duffed second and third shots, pitched it in from 75m out. He would have been happy with a par, but had to settle for birdie and zero putts.

I personally found the bunkers a nightmare, especially when the ball plugged. On the 10th, I managed the trifecta and landed in all three bunkers on the right. After about six shots, which included a couple of double hits, I made it to the green. Not a great start to the back 9.



Putting was not the best for the majority of players as only 5 players were under 40 putts: Stefan Moskaljuk 33, Slawko Kohut 37, Mike Ward 37, Andrew Hluchanic 38 and Jerry Cymbalak 39.

The speed of play needs to improve for our games, as there was a huge gap from the first to last (fifth) group.



Golf tip: Don't Get "Stuck" on the Downswing

If you've watched much professional golf on television, you've heard commentators opine about players getting "stuck" on the downswing, causing either a push or a hook. Here's what they're talking about – and how to avoid it.

Getting "stuck" refers to a downswing in which the arms and hands lag too far behind the hips and chest. This is also called getting the arms "trapped" behind the body. Typically, two things happen: Either the clubhead fails to catch up at impact, sending the ball right (called "blocking" the shot); or the player, subconsciously sensing the timing error, slows the lower body and/or speeds up the arms and hands, flipping them at the last instant and producing a hook.

Getting stuck produces an exaggerated inside-to-out clubhead path into the ball, often with the arms and hands too close to the body. Try this practice drill to overcome the tendency:

- 1. Place a light object, such as a clubhead cover or water bottle, a foot or so behind the ball and about six inches inside the line.
- 2. Make a backswing that takes the club outside the object (in other words, the object is between you and the clubhead).
- 3. Hit the ball with the club again traveling outside the object, along the line of your takeaway.

This drill will force your arms farther from your body and help keep the hips, chest and arms in synch.
