Recipe

Potato and Cauliflower soup

1-1½ tblsp butter
1 tblsp canola oil
1 large onion, chopped
2 cloves garlic, crushed
½ tsp ground turmeric
1 tsp ground cumin
1 tsp garam masala

800g coliban potatoes, peeled & chopped
1 cauliflower, cut into florets
2 litres chicken stock
140 g plain yoghurt
Chopped fresh chives, for garnish

Serves 6 - 8

1. Heat butter and oil in a large saucepan, add onion and garlic, and stir until onion softens (but do not brown). Add combined spices and stir until fragrant.
2. Add potatoes, cauliflower, stock and 1½ cups water to the pan and bring to the boil. Reduce heat and simmer, covered, until vegetables are softened (this will take 20-30 minutes).
3. Blend or process the soup until smooth. Serve in bowls topped with plain yoghurt and chopped fresh chives.
