AUVGC Rule for the month

Unplayable

A player may under the penalty of one (1) stroke, deem his ball unplayable at any place on the course, except when the ball is in a water hazard. The player is the sole judge.

The player has the option of either:

- Dropping the ball in the approximate area, 2 club lengths, no closer to the hole, OR
- Drop the ball behind the point where the ball lay keeping that point directly between the hole and the spot in which the ball is dropped, with no limit how far that ball may be dropped.
