As Tony mentioned at the Club Championship, we are organising a **4-day golf tournament** in **Queenstown**, **New Zealand in March 2014**. The proposed arrival date: Sunday 2 March 2014 and departure Saturday 8 March 2014 (to be confirmed).

The proposed schedule is:

- 2 days of golf
- 1 rest day
- 2 days of golf, followed by a presentation dinner

Costs:

The cost is based on a group of 20 – 30 golfers plus partners.

The cost varies depending on room type and hotel we choose, and the range is:

- Golfers between \$1100 and \$1400
- Non Golfers between \$650 and \$850

The package includes:

- ♦ 6 nights' accommodation
- 4 rounds of golf (1 x Kelvin Heights, 1 x Millbrook and 2 rounds at Jackson's Point)
- ♦ Electric carts at Jackson's Point (carts for other games user pays)
- Golf and airport transfers
- ♦ Presentation dinner 3 course meal
- ♦ Clubs can be hired and the cost will be approx \$120 for the week.
